Number 1 Rule as we introduce soccer to players and their families. We are here to have soccer fun!!!!

		Before the game:		
		First Game of the day? Grab two corner flags from equipment room.		
		Pickup game card from porch and hand to referee at the field.		
		Inspect the field for defects, ants, trash, etc.		
		PARENTS ON SPECTATOR SIDE PLAYERS W/ COACH ON OPPOSITE SIDE.		
		Line the kids up and introduce everyone.		
		Inspect players for shin guards, no jewelry, no splints, nothing dangerous to self or others.		
		Toss a coin winner picks end to defend the other kicks off.		
During the game:				
		The maximum number of players on the field at any time will be eleven (11) per team.  • We play even sided always		
ı	1 coach per team on the sideline			
l	Referee to assist in safe play. If no referee is available both coaches are allowed on the field to assist.			
		No parents or extra coaches behind the goal		
		Substitutions at the quarter or injury (Approx 12 ½ Minutes).		
		Give yourself 15 minutes every practice to work with everyone on basic goalie concepts.		
		Games will consist of two ~30-minute halves with a ~10-minute halftime. Running clock ONLY.		
		Offside will be called. Referee will call this, and it depends on when the ball is kicked and where the attacking players are.		
ſ	$\neg$	No change in regular start of play (kickoff) rules, other than opposing players will be at least five yards away from the spot of		
		the free kick.		
[		Touchline - ball out, thrown in from the area that it went out. Please follow the proper rules here, ball completely over the head, both feet maintain contact with the ground, and ball goes in.		
		Balls kicked out over the goal line (not into the Goal Kick – It goes over the goal line from the other team.		
		goal) will be set for either scenario  Corner Kick – It goes over the goal line from the defending team or goalie.		
		No change in regular scoring rules. DISCOURAGE RUNAWAY SCORES!!! (substitute positions on the field)		
		Direct free kicks will be awarded for all fouls, with the opponents eight yards away.		
		If a player shows reckless/dangerous play, uses foul language, or dissents against the ref they will be issued a Yellow or		
		Red Card based on the Referees decision.		
[		1 Yellow – Sent off the field for cool off period.		
		<ul> <li>2 Yellows = Red Card – Sent off the field immediately and will not be able to play the next game.</li> </ul>		
		Red - Sent off the field immediately and will not be able to play the next game.		
[	$\neg$	Substitutions need to be sent to the half line, and the coach needs to let the referee know he/she has a sub. The referee will let		
		you know when the substitution can take place.		
After the game:				
		This is the part they will remember the most!!!		
		Teams line up and thank each other for the game, teams thank the other coach, and finally thank Referees.		
[		Clap, Holler, and Encourage as they all run through it in the same direction!!		
		Popsicle at the Concession Stand.		
		Make sure you review Game Card and Sign it.
