

8U Soccer Guidelines

Ages: 6 and 7 Year Olds		
Teams: Boys and Girls Separate Divisions		
Fields: 5, 5A, 9A, 9B, 9C – 5 & 5A		
5& 5A are by the parking lot next to concession area		
9A-9C are in between the two large fields in the center of the complex		

Basics: 15-20 Minute Practice 10 Min Quarters 4 Quarters Throw Ins

Size 3 Ball Shin Guards 4 on Field No Goalie

Number 1 Rule as we introduce soccer to players and their families. We are here to have soccer fun!!!!

Before the game:		
	First Game of the day? Grab two corner flags from equipment room.	
	Pickup game card from porch.	
	Inspect the field for defects, ants, trash, etc.	
	PARENTS ON SPECTATOR SIDE PLAYERS W/ COACH ON OPPOSITE SIDE.	
	Line the kids up and introduce everyone.	
	Inspect players for shin guards, no jewelry, no splints, nothing dangerous to self or others.	
	Mini Pratice Session for 15-20 minutes	
	Toss a coin winner picks end to defend the other kicks off.	
During the game:		
	The maximum number of players on the field at any time will be four (4) per team.	
	We play even sided always.	
	• 1 coach per team on the field.	
	No parents or extra coaches behind the goal.	
	Substitutions at the quarter or injury.	
	No goalkeepers. (no offense or defense inside the goal area or arc in front of goal)	
	Games will consist of four 5-minute quarters with a 5-minute halftime. Running clock ONLY.	
	No change in regular start of play (kickoff) rules, other than opposing players will be at least five yards away from the spot of the free kick.	
	Sideline - ball out, be generous with the out of bounds line, and when you call it out, please use a quick throw in to restart.	
	Balls kicked out over the goal line (not into the goal) will be KICKED back into play from where they crossed the goal line by a player of the opposing team.	
	No change in regular scoring rules. We don't keep score. We don't keep standing. DISCOURAGE RUNAWAY SCORES!!! (substitute positions on the field)	
	Direct free kicks will be awarded for all fouls, with the opponents five yards away.	
After the game:		
	This is the part they will remember the most!!!	
	Get a Tunnel setup with parents and spectators.	
	Clap, Holler, and Encourage as they all run through it in the same direction!!	
	Popsicle at the Concession Stand.	
	Turn in Game Card.	
	Last game of the day? Grab corner flags and turn them in.
